D.0 Public Meeting and Agency Coordination

D.1 Public Information Meeting

Two Public Information Meetings were conducted to inform the general public and interested stakeholders about the recommendations of the Airport Master Plan Update and to solicit public comment during the project's implementation. The Project Team coordinated the meeting logistics and facilitated the public meetings as appropriate.



The Tallahassee International Airport's Master Plan Update Public Information Meeting #1 was held on May 12, 2016 at the Center for Workforce Development, Tallahassee Community College. There were 38 attendees present and 13 written comments are included as part of this appendix.

The "open house" meeting format included an oral presentation accompanied by a slide presentation by Phil Jufko of Michael Baker International, Inc. The oral presentation included information relative

to the overall airport master planning process, existing facilities, aviation forecasts, and next steps in the Study. Representatives of the consultant team were available at various stations to answer questions from members from the local community.

The second Public Information Meeting was held on March 30, 2017 at the Center for Workforce Development, Tallahassee Community College. There were 21 attendees present and five (5) written comments regarding the Study's preliminary recommendations for future airport development are included in this appendix. Members of the consultant team were available at various stations to answer questions from members of the local community.



Comments received during the Public Information Meetings were taken into consideration in the development the 2019 TLH Master Plan Update.

D.2 Agency Coordination

As part of the master planning process, key components of the Airport Master Plan Update must be coordinated with representatives of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Aviation Office for approval. This includes submittal of the Aviation Forecasts and the Airport Layout Plan drawing set.

D.2.1 Aviation Forecast Review and Approval

The Aviation Forecasts associated with this study were prepared in accordance with Advisory Circular AC 150/5070-6B, Airport Master Plans and submitted to the FAA's Orlando Airports District Office (ADO) in accordance with the FAA's Memorandum pertaining to FAA Review and Approval of Aviation Forecasts, dated December 23, 2004. Correspondence pertaining to the review and approval of the Master Plan Update forecast is included at the end of this appendix.

D.2.2 Airport Layout Plan Review and Conditional Approval

The Airport Layout Plan drawing set approval process consists of multiple submittals to the airport sponsor, the FAA, and the FDOT. Upon completion of the final draft of the technical report and Airport Layout Plan drawing set, the Draft ALP and supporting documentation was submitted to the FAA's Orlando ADO for initial review and comment. Upon addressing the ADO's initial round of comments, the Draft Airport Layout Plan drawing set was resubmitted to the ADO for distribution to various FAA offices for airspace review. Following this process, the drawing set was revised based on the airspace determination and review comments received. The Final Airport Layout Plan drawing set and accompanying Airport Master Plan Update Report was submitted to the FAA and FDOT for distribution and Conditional Approval. Correspondence pertaining to the review and approval of the Airport Layout Plan drawing set is included at the end of this appendix.

This plant is only in 6 counties in all of the United States (all of which are in FL) and has been greatly reduced in numbers because of fire suppression.

Bottomline: I would love your help in saving these plants and the declining butterfly populations that use them. All we want is to be put in contact with the people that can reduce the mow schedule and the people that can give us access to the land so we can relocate the plants to protected locations.
